

Show Committee Meeting
October 24, 2010

Meeting Called to order by Mike Green @ 10:45

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion was made to accept by Vicky and 2nd by Marleen – Motion Passed

Parish – We lost money on the Parish show due to low attendance. 16 horses + non color horses.

Elmira – Chemung County Fair Grounds is under new management and are considering lowering costs for next year. The show was small and therefore we lost \$3,571.00 total. 28 horses.

Breeders – Attendance was 30 horses.

State Fair – Attendance was low.

Cobleskill – Some people really love the show, some thought it was excessively expensive. 16 horses attended which is about normal.

Paint – Good show. Large trail classes. 17 horses which is up a little bit. Change in show management didn't affect our showing.

Judges – One Judge complaint; Vicky Radtke was expensive and unpleasant, so we won't be asking her back. Don Coats was wonderful. The Judges that are able to drive in are much less expensive.

Futurities – One weanling and one walk/jog entry. We have two years worth of ribbons in stock. Marleen made a motion to table the futurity for 2011 and revisit next year, 2nd by Lynn – motion passed with one abstention Vicky suggested that we hold a weanling challenge instead for a cooler. Darlene will see if she can get a cooler donated. (If not Karen will supply a cooler.) Darlene made a motion that we have a free Palomino weanling challenge class, all entries must go in a PHBA weanling class, 2nd by Jen - motion passed

Show Program – Marleen made a motion to leave the order in the program the same for Halter, Showmanship, Color. 2nd by Jen – Motion passed

Jen made a motion to have a paid practice time on the trail course limited to 15 minutes prior to the trail class which will remain between performance and games on the program. The money will be added to the show bill. - 2nd by Marleen – motion passed.

Mike & Shannon will go over what ribbons will be needed for next year.

Remove all futurity classes, add weanling challenge, add amateur hunter in hand for each sex.

Old business – no old business

New Business – Southern Tier Quarter Horse Association is interested in holding a Palomino show in conjunction with their show. Shannon will contact them for details of what they have in mind and we will discuss at the November meeting.

2011 show season – Lynn is looking into having a show at a private facility in Owego. They will have more information in November. Marleen made a motion to have a one day show at a date and location to be determined. 2nd by Renee – motion passed.

NE Futurity show – Mike will get the information for the Chemung grounds to compare to Cobleskill. We will discuss at the November meeting.
